RE: Campus-Wide Closing Policy Related to Inclement Weather

These past few weeks have seen record-breaking snow falls leading to many disruptions of activities on campus. I want to take a moment to reiterate our weather-related closing policy. We will continue to follow the Baltimore County Public School system for weather-related closings. This week, due to the extenuating circumstances, we deviated from that policy in an effort to return our students back to their classes after a long absence.

- When Baltimore County Public Schools are closed, all activities on campus (athletics, school activities and group meetings on campus) **are automatically cancelled**. There will be no 6:30 am daily Mass; the 8:30 am daily Mass will still be held.
- An early dismissal by Baltimore County Public Schools will also automatically cancel all events on campus (athletics, school activities and group meetings on campus) for that evening as well. If there is an early dismissal due to inclement weather, there will be no Extended Day that afternoon. Parents must make arrangements to pick up their children promptly.
- When school is cancelled on a Friday, weekend activities are subject to cancellation after a review of the campus conditions (parking, roads, snow removal). Participants may check the parish website (www.theimmaculate.org) or call the Parish Office main telephone number (410-427-4700) to see if their events are still scheduled for that day. The status of weekend school events will be announced via an Alert or Dispatch message.
- The times for weekend Masses are subject to change based on weather conditions. Please check the parish website (www.theimmaculate.org) or call the Parish Office main number (410-427-4700) for an up-to-date Mass schedule. The status of the Adoration Chapel can be obtained by calling 410-427-4711.

We have implemented these polices to ensure the safety of our students, staff and parishioners. Thank you for your cooperation.
