

**Tuition Assistance Information for
Immaculate Conception School**

2010-2011 Tuition

\$5,690 per child K through Grade 8
\$2,190 per child – 4 yr. old (3 Day) - \$2,970 per child (Pre-K)
\$1,910 per child – 3 year old

- Q. Do you have to be a parishioner to take advantage of the tuition assistance program?**
- A. YES - The money for tuition assistance is coming from parish collections. When a family with school children transfers from one parish to another without changing residences and wishes to enroll children in the school associated with the new parish, there must be a waiting period of one year after enrolling before the family is eligible for tuition assistance from the new parish. During this waiting period, the family must be contributing to our church through the weekly envelope system.
- Q. Who is a parishioner?**
- A. Anyone registered with the parish and contributing to our church through the weekly envelope system.
- Q. If I have more than one child in the school, do I have to fill out one form for each child?**
- A. NO – but be sure that Sections D, G and H are completed accurately.
- Q. What do I do if the form doesn't ask for information that I feel is important to my financial situation?**
- A. Use Section K. If necessary, attach a letter.
- Q. When will I be informed of the decision?**
- A. 1. All forms with Federal Income Tax Return **MUST** be mailed to PSAS (Private School Aid Service) by March 16, 2010.
2. PSAS will send us a printout by April 15, 2010.
3. All parents will be notified by May 14, 2010.
- Q. Who makes the final decision?**
- A. The Parish Finance Committee.
- Q. Who should apply?**
- A. Anyone who is a registered parishioner at Church of the Immaculate Conception and uses offertory envelopes.
