Dear Parents,

The Baltimore County Police Department provides a crossing guard for schools to assist children at dangerous intersections. This service requires that the children be legitimate walkers. With parent permission and school verification, the students are walking on foot from a school property to a nearby residence or office destination.

This year all qualified ICS walking students will leave the breezeway at school, pass the adoration chapel and follow the sidewalk down the front hill with three supervising teachers. This one line will walk to the Joppa, Bosley corner of the Parish. Our teachers will remain with the children on the north-east corner of our school property and then transfer them to the responsibility of the crossing guard at that Joppa, Bosley corner.

Older students, with parent permission and school verification, may walk to their registered destination alone. Younger students, with school verification, must be met by an adult and continue walking to their destination together.

No adult picking up students may park a car, meet the children, and drive directly away.

If your child qualifies as a walker, complete this form and return it to your child's homeroom teacher.

We appreciate your joining us in keeping your children/our students safe.
