

## **Middle School Supply List**

### **Supplies to be purchased by EACH student for their homeroom:**

2 packs of REINFORCED, COLLEGE-RULED loose leaf

1 pack of dry erase markers for classroom use (students should have their own as well)

6th graders only: 1 container of disinfecting wipes and 1 package of pencils

7th graders only: 1 roll of paper towels and 1 package of pens (blue or black)

8th graders only: 2 boxes of tissues

### **Subject-Specific Supplies for Students:**

Two (2) large 2" or 3" binders to be SHARED. One will be for **Math and ELA**, the other for **Social Studies and Religion**. Students should have loose leaf in the binders for each subject. *(The shared binders are being used to help reduce the number of supplies a student needs to purchase and carry.)*

#### **Spanish:**

1 subject spiral notebook

1 2-pocket plastic folder

1 package of index cards

#### **Religion:**

2 packages of dividers (5 count each) to be used with large shared binder

#### **Language Arts:**

1 package of dividers (5 count)

1 pack of multi-colored pens, 5 or more colors required for annotating

#### **Social Studies:**

1 package of dividers (5-count)

#### **Math:**

One (1) package of graph paper

3 tab dividers

Protractor & compass (bulls eye is preferable)

7th and 8th grade **Algebra I & Geometry ONLY** – graphing calculator (TI-84 recommended)

#### **Science:**

1 2-pocket plastic folder with brackets or fasteners

**Each student is expected to have the following supplies on hand for their personal use throughout the school year:**

#2 pencils

Black or blue pens

Red pens

highlighters

dry erase markers

Pencil case (soft- separate from art box and used for everyday supplies)

Reinforced loose leaf paper for all binders

Ruler with inch and centimeter markings

Ear buds

Art box consisting of: scissors, large glue stick, Scotch tape, crayons, colored markers, colored pencils, and white glue. *(These will be used in multiple subjects.)*
