Welcome back to a new and exciting ICAA basketball season! This flyer describes our programs and the registration process. As always, ICAA basketball is open to boys and girls of all abilities. Dates listed below are tentative, and may change due to facility availability.

Basketball Clinic, Grade 2 and younger (age 5 by 12-31-17): Learn basic skills and teamwork in a fun and enriching environment. Clinic sessions will be conducted Saturday mornings at ICS, January 6 through February 27. Parent coaches and assistants are vital to the success of the program; even if you have no coaching experience, this is a great forum for kids and parents to learn the game together. Registrations will be accepted through January 5, but may close earlier if the program becomes full; recommend that you register your child by December 1.

Grade 3: Separate boys and girls teams participate in a Sunday afternoon league held at ICS that includes teams from other parishes. The primary objective of this program is to give children the skills and Christian attitude necessary for CYO basketball competition in grades 4 through 8. Practices will be held Wednesday evenings beginning in early-November; Sunday games will begin December 10 and run through mid-February. Registration is open through October 31. Please consider volunteering to coach a team!

CYO Basketball, Grades 4 – 8: CYO basketball promotes good sportsmanship and basketball skills in a framework of Catholic values. Twice-weekly practices begin in early November, and league games, held at Archdiocesan schools, start in December and run through February. League champions play in the CYO tournament in March. ***Registrations must be received by October 10 to meet CYO deadlines.*** Coaches, assistants, and team parents are needed to keep the ball bouncing!

COST (per child): Clinic – \$45 (\$55 after Dec. 1)
Grade 3 – \$55 (\$65 after Oct. 31)
CYO Grades 4 to 8 – \$115 (\$125 after Oct. 10)
