PBIS STUDENT EXPECTATIONS AT ICS



Cafeteria:

Playground:

Be a good sport; encourage others to do their best; take proper care of recess equipment; stop when whistle blows; share; be safe; take turns; resolve conflicts peacefully.



Bathroom:

Give privacy to others; keep bathroom clean; make good choices; wait your turn; respect school property; wash hands; turn off water; report problems to teachers; use positive tone and words.



Church:

Be silent when appropriate; genuflect; kneel and pray before mass; use comfortable, but attentive posture; participate joyfully in Mass; sing; extend polite sign of peace; demonstrate Catholic values inside & outside of Church.



Hallways:

Be silent in stairwells; follow teacher directions; walk safely; return to class promptly; keep hallways clear; smile and be courteous.
